Hi,

The output volumes from cisTEM reconstructions are stored in your project directory, in the Assets/Volumes directory. By default the half maps are not stored, you will have to run a generate3d job with "save half maps" set to yes to save the half maps.

Also, all the programs in cisTEM can be run from the command line, so you can script cisTEM to run basically in the same way as Frealign if you would prefer to not use the GUI.
