I need to use a larger percentage in the final stages as I am limited by the number of particles in my whole stack. I tried to delete the project and start a new one, but the issue is the same. I also tried to reinstall cisTEM, but still I do have the issue. Moreover when I deleted the whole cisTEM package and re-install it, the brand new re-installed version of cisTEM, somehow remembers my old projects that I created before on the workstation. How is that possible? Could this be some sort of a bug or compatibility issue as I am running it on a workstation with ubuntu 16.04?
