From how I understand the program it sounds like quitting the GUI during active refinements could make cisTEM "sad", which I would definitely want to avoid! (although I haven't been brave enough to try it yet)

The reason I am asking is it is common for me to want to start a job while remotely connected to a cluster from my laptop, i.e. from home. Then when I travel somewhere my internet link will get severed- which I expect to disrupt everything.

The alternative would be to get ahold of a terminal command that would execute the equivalent of a refinement job- but I haven't found documentation on how to do this yet..
